Please be advised that our sister union UNAC is attempting to finalize a contract with Kaiser to cover certain classifications of nursing professionals that have expressed an interest in joining the union and the Partnership. During these negotiations unfortunately the union and the company have reached an impasse and now these workers will be conducting picketing at different medical centers on different days throughout the week of April 7<sup>th</sup>.

While Local 30 certainly supports our sisters and brothers in UNAC as they attempt to resolve their differences with Kaiser we must honor our existing contract and continue to be at work as scheduled. UNAC is asking that all regularly assigned members of other bargaining units report for work as usual and anyone interested in walking the line with their members do so on their off shift hours only.

Local 30 will continue to work with UNAC in other ways to help to resolve this dispute as quickly as possible and support the members of UNAC in all ways possible. In addition, the Coalition of Kaiser Permanente Unions in Southern California has pledged to support UNAC throughout this struggle as well.

We should all hope for the best outcome for these workers, and show our support for them in whatever ways we can.
