2008 PRE BARGAINING MEETINGS - REVISED

Dear Local 30 member,

As employees at Kaiser Permanente and the California Service Center you are no doubt aware that our National Agreement calls for a bargaining reopener in 2008 for the subjects of wages and retiree medical benefits. Bargaining over these two issues is set to begin in July. In keeping with our commitment to inform our members about such issues I have scheduled a series of meetings around San Diego County to make it convenient for you to attend.

At these meetings we will discuss the process of reopener bargaining, the National structure, the two issues that will be discussed, the current economics of our proposals, and the schedule for bargaining and ratification. Members will have an opportunity to have their questions answered as well, and offer comments and advice. The meetings will be one hour in length and conducted either during lunch hours and/or immediately after work hours. The schedule, times and locations of the meetings are listed below.
